First there are some changes coming to GWRRA. This is a summary of those changes,

Members!

Some of you may have already seen or heard that there is change coming to GWRRA. This is to share with you the changes that will be happening and we want you to hear it from us.

Below are the links to the videos to introduce the changes. The one that says Members is for all to watch and a great place to start. If you want more details, the second video is for Officers but anyone can watch.

Here is a brief overview.

The change to our Chapters is to shift them from feeling like they had to have a meeting each month to do the "business" of GWRRA, to more of a get together to share stories, adventures, safety tips and any new information from GWRRA and then to go for a ride. Specifically, you'll see that we have taken the Rider Educator away from the Chapter. We have added a Chapter Ride Coordinator who will be an Officer of Rider Ed. This move is to facilitate a softer approach to our Rider Education Program, often called the Levels Program, and move the program promotion and administration to the District. We want the Ride Coordinator to share safety tips on riding, clothing, preparing for a ride and more in an effort to guide our Members to adopt our safe riding philosophy. Our approach will be different with our Members but our message will still talk about rider safety. Our primary goal with this change is to help our Chapters to create adventures, memories, friendships, social time and great motorcycle rides for the enjoyment of the Members of GWRRA.

Our Districts will gain some responsibilities but we want them to focus on building great memories, have adventures and great rides and enjoying the Members, while they bring a great message from the Program they represent to all of our Members, whether they affiliate with a Chapter or not. The District will open their arms wide to make certain you are included in the fun!

To be more responsive to our Members TEAM GWRRA will be engaging more with our Members and be guiding our District level of Volunteers. With this major change we have, starting January 1, 2018, removed our Regions from our current structure and opened up all Districts to interact with other Districts regardless of lines on a map. Our focus is to our Members wherever they live.

Throughout the next 6 months you'll see how some of the Programs will change and add new recognitions. Feel free to ask questions at any time to your Director, TEAM GWRRA or to me.

I ask that you follow my favorite saying from Gary Keller, "stay into curiosity and out of judgement" and open your mind to the positive that these changes can bring to our Association. I know that change can be a challenge, but together we will bring about a bright new future to GWRRA.

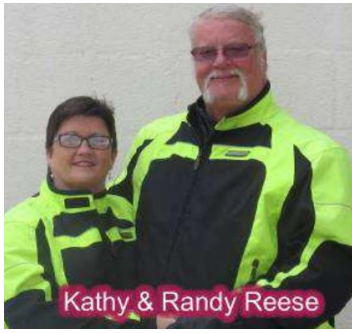

From the District Educators

Hello GWRRA family, Kathy and I are still on the road, and by the time you read this we will be wandering down Route 66 back to Texas. It's been an amazing journey!

You have probably heard or read about some of the Texas District staff changes that have occurred since our May Rally. We want to first add our welcome to our new District Directors, Jim and Alvalin Woodul! We have known and worked with them for several years and are excited to have them on board. They are strong supporters of Rider Education and we are already planning some area and statewide training opportunities for our membership. Watch for announcements in the next few months.

We are also very proud to announce our new Assistant District Educator - Chris Schoenthal. Chris is the Educator for Chapter M in Mansfield. He is very involved in his chapter and has helped every member enter and progress through the Levels program. Chris is a Level IV Master Tour Rider and is certified as an ITCP and MFA/CPR Instructor. He is very knowledgeable about GWRRA and general operations. Chris' primary responsibility will be to oversee all First Aid/CPR classes, but he can also help Chapter Educators and members locate and set up riding classes. He will be a strong addition to our team and we welcome him aboard.

Scott and Judy Finnell will remain on the District Team as the Motorist Awareness Coordinators. Motorist Awareness is now a separate entity from Rider Education but we will continue to work closely with them to educate the public about sharing the road with us.

As you can probably tell from the District Team Page, we also have several other new people in former and newly created positions. We look forward to the new energy they will provide to our GWRRA activities. Note that Jim Scholes, another one of our Educators (Chapter S2) and ITCP instructor is now the Assistant District Trainer, too. Welcome aboard Batman! Finally, Dale and Carleen Garrett (Educators for Chapter T) are also now the District Couple of the Year Coordinators. They have been through the process through the International level and will be very helpful guiding others through the process.

Now that we've finished bragging on our Educators, let's do a quick Rider Education segment.

Kathy and I are members of the Texas Motorcycle Safety Coalition. They do a lot of research and recently released a Five Year Motorcycle Crash Analysis.

Researchers found:

- The number of registered motorcycles doubled from 179,329 in 2000 to 445,395 in 2014. This dramatic increase suggests that crashes with motorcycles will continue to be a traffic safety issue.

- The counties with the most motorcycle registrations were Bexar, Collin, Dallas, Denton, El Paso, Harris, Montgomery, Tarrant, and Travis, which corresponds to the most populated areas of Texas.
- In 2015, there were over 8,000 motorcycle crashes. The severity of those crashes were classified as:
 - 6 percent fatal injury
 - 22 percent incapacitating injury
 - 38 percent non-incapacitating injury
 - 21 percent possible injury
 - 14 percent no injury
 - The percentage of crashes classified as fatal or incapacitating is similar from 2010 to 2015.
- Overall more crashes occur in urban areas (70 percent) but rural crashes are more severe. Of rural motorcycle crashes, 36 percent resulted in a fatal or incapacitating injury compared to 23 percent in urban areas.
- The rate of fatal or incapacitating motorcycle crashes was 8.4 per 100,000 population in 2015.

SIDECAR: Experience advanced techniques of riding with a sidecar as well as situation strategies and accident avoidance tactics. 8 hours (3 classroom/5 range).

TRAILERING: Learn advanced trailering techniques and strategies for safe and enjoyable travel. Motorcycles only--no trikes or sidecars please. 8 hours (3 classroom/5 range)

TRIKE: This course teaches advanced riding skills for the trike rider such as maximum braking, swerving and turning. 8 hours (3 classroom/5 range)
