

Happy Saint Patrick's Day,

Here we are at the end of March 2023, we are approximately one month away from our Texas District rally in Kerrville, Texas. This is the Yellow Rose rally! The closer we get the more excited I get. Plenty of new ideas are going into the planning-this will look completely different from the last rally. In a good way. I am looking forward to seeing the Elvis impersonator, to watching people go out on rides and come back with big smiles on their faces, people taking one of four classes to sharpen their skills on the motorcycle, or friends coming back from a good meal at one of the many Kerrville dining establishments. I must admit I was a bit nervous as we began planning for this event in January. Was it enough time? Last year we began the planning in the fall, and I felt a sense of anxiety up until the very last day. But honestly, I truly believe that was inexperience weighing upon us all. The truth is we have an awesome team and several great chapter members who are leaping in to help in both the planning and execution of this rally. We have people coming in from all over the country and on a variety of motorcycles. The flavor of this rally will be much more about riding and camaraderie. We are becoming a lot smarter about the events, prizes, [and] entertainment to appeal to a wider audience. It will be really neat to see what you all think of it. Make sure to talk to your chapters and encourage as many people as possible to attend. Any profits raised will be used for the benefit of the chapters and the chapter members. This is all for you and we are volunteers working for the members of this organization.

One of the greatest things about all of this is that spring is in the air in Texas. The temperatures are getting warmer, the leaves and flowers are blossoming, and allergies are in full swing. This brings up a very important public service announcement or rather suggestion. Be very mindful of the over the counter medications you are taking to control hay fever and seasonal allergies. Most of these medications will cause drowsiness and a lack of focus that can be deadly when riding a motorcycle. Additionally, as the weather gets warmer, concerns about dehydration must be taken seriously. Many of the medications that we take as we get older will help rob us of hydration and before we know it we are starting to have riding problems. I know that personally this has affected me almost every single season. And you usually do not notice until you stop after a couple hours. As the temperatures get warmer, make more frequent stops to drink plenty of liquids, and I'm not talking coffee. Coffee is a diuretic and will make you dehydrate quicker. Plus, nobody enjoys the more frequent bathroom breaks associated. Another misnomer is that ice cold water is the solution to both dehydration, and overheating. Frankly, ice cold water is a shock to your digestive tract, and has been known to put people into shock. Better to have a beverage that is slightly colder than room temperature and plenty of it.

Donna and I are making serious changes to our health and are renewing our commitment to riding the motorcycles much more often. It'll be necessary to fight the variety of time killers we all have in life that get us away from the road. But as I get older, I realized there are less days of riding ahead, than I have behind me, and I must take advantage of my abilities, while I can. Combined, Donna and I have lost over 100 pounds. My blood sugar is far more stable now that I have a continuous monitor and that I'm carefully watching my diet. As the weight comes off we all find that our activity levels increase and our ability to do so becomes so much easier. I'm not talking about jogging a marathon, but I am talking about getting back to the day-to-day movements that keep us all in the best shape possible, for the shape we're in. We will be spending much of our spring heading to the variety of rallies being held, i.e., the Bluebonnet Rally in Fredericksburg being held by Chapter O "The Capital Wings", the Louisiana District Rally being held in Monroe La, and finishing off April, our great Yellow Rose Rally! Arkansas is not too far away at the end of May, and Donna and I will be doing our first long distance trip in approximately 4 years. We will be riding first to Greenville SC, then on with friends up to Americade in Lake George NY. We will continue riding around the northeast for a week or two, only to head back to Greenville South Carolina to attend the South Carolina District Rally June 1st through the 3rd. And then we head home. I am not too sure how much more rally time we will have the rest of the year, as time away from work will be more limited, and inflation is making this perhaps our last hurrah for a while. This means more local riding with our chapter "the Rally Cats", "the Pleasure Riders", "the Roadrunners" and as many other chapters as we can.

We hope to see you all soon, be safe, practice all the skills you have learned over the years!


