As most of you know, the GWRRA founders announced at Wing Ding 43 that GWRRA would be shutting down after 45 years. It was announced that pro-rated refunds for remaining dues and road assistance plans would be made starting in August. We were told that District rallies planned before the end of the year would still happen.

There is a move to create a new association called Eagle Wings Motorcycle Association headed up by past GWRRA President Anita Alkire and partners.

Although GWRRA has closed effective July 31st, insurance will be in effect for District Rallies until December 31st. If you had Rescue Plus with your membership, it is no longer in effect as of 31 July 2022. So, please check your other insurance options such as your motorcycle, house, RV policies so you're not without help in case you need it for you motorcycle.

Things are still in flux with many decisions to be made. For now, our chapter will continue to meet on the first and third Tuesdays as we normally do. It just won't be under the GWRRA.

I'm sure there will be more information in the coming weeks / months regarding what may be done to continue our fellowship.

## Gold Wing Road Riders Association

founders Paul Hildebrand and Shirley Stevens-Garcia announced during Wing Ding 43 opening ceremonies that the organization will be closing. American Honda is saddened by the news and thanks the GWRRA for its dedication to one of Honda's most iconic models.

Founded in 1977, the GWRRA grew through the heyday of motorcycle touring to the point that it eventually had approximately 80,000 members in 53 countries, and with over 800 active chapters managed by 4,000 volunteer leaders. Headquartered in Phoenix, Arizona, the GWRRA has called itself "the world's largest single-marque social organization for owners of Honda Gold Wing/Valkyrie motorcycles," and it adopted the motto "Friends for Fun, Safety and Knowledge."

A dedicated, family-like group that published its own magazine (*Wing World*, whose September issue will be the last), the GWRRA worked hard to improve the image of motorcycling and prided itself in being a not-for-profit, non-religious, non-political organization whose members covered a broad spectrum of backgrounds, but who were unified by a love for owning and riding Honda's legendary touring model, the Gold Wing.

"We would like to thank our members, vendors and advertisers for 45 years of unwavering support," said Abel Gallardo, COO of GWRRA. "We truly could not have made it this far without all of you. To our rider-education program, we cannot begin to place a number on the lives touched by your efforts. To our leadership-training and motorist-awareness programs, thank you for educating our members, officers and public to keep our riders safe and enjoying the ride."

The GWRRA will officially close on July 31. In the interim, it will offer prorated refunds on prepaid memberships.

"For nearly five decades, the GWRRA has set the powersports standard for a grassroots organization based on a single model, and Honda will be forever grateful for the enthusiasm the club's members demonstrated and generated for the Gold Wing," said Bill Savino, American Honda Senior Manager of Customer Engagement. "While the GWRRA's closure is undeniably the end of an era, we want to make sure their members and all Gold Wing enthusiasts know that Honda remains committed to the Gold Wing model and these customers for years to come."

# Texas District Director News

Dan and Donna Rymarz, Texas District Directors

The last time I wrote one of these, I was discussing our upcoming trip to Wing Ding and how excited we all were. The prospects for being with friends, for having fun, and for finding out where the next Wing Ding would be, was all at the forefront of our minds. All I can say is, “holy crap!” I never expected the shocker we were in for.

First, the cold hard facts. GWRRA International has been dissolved. The official last day of GWRRA as an international organization and Arizona Home Office comes to a close on July 31, 2022. The Home Office is closing itself down and with it, all organizational structures below. The financial final day will be December 31, 2022. All members will get a prorated refund of their dues and Rescue Plus fees at the end of August. *Wing World* magazine will conclude its final printing also in August. As far as GWRRA international was concerned, 2022 is the last and final Wing Ding. There is still much we need to find out about the accounting part of GWRRA. Conflicting information was passed around at the rally, So there will be more to come regarding the old organization.

As to the why this happened, it's not that difficult to see. The organization had gone from 80,000 members down to 10,000 over the years. While they stopped creating lifetime members that did not have to pay any dues (old Life), many of the new life members grew monthly. The dues for those new life members were substantially lower, and with decreased membership abroad, GWRRA was soon to reach the point where it would be losing money. This along with the advanced age of our founders, the future was looking bleak at least from an International Association point of view. International had become quite top heavy, and a drastic change had to occur.

As to the future, almost immediately at the end of the speech announcing the shutdown, District Directors, and Chapter Directors all began discussing how we felt about what we just heard. The almost immediate conclusion was that international perhaps wasn't really needed. If Chapters continue to meet and ride, nothing needs to change at all. The view was and is a simplification of the whole idea of GWRRA. The pieces were coalescing almost immediately into something that focused on the members and riding. Obviously much deeper discussion would have to occur regarding tax

status, training, insurance and the lot, but at least for the time immediately after the announcement, everyone was coming up with a plan.

The unexpected twist: the next day, Anita Alkire, the former president of our organization, spoke to the groups to discuss the possibility of a recreation of the international association, under a new name, under a leaner structure with less of the original offerings of membership, and a more simple purpose of riding and socializing. There wasn't much to go on, or really anything to decide off of, but for all of us who were surprised by the announcement, this was a potential idea worth entertaining. Was it to be a new opportunity to rebuild our association to be leaner and more focused, and perhaps appeal to a wider variety of riders, a younger range of members, and a renewed purpose? This past week Anita announced the organization's new name chosen by herself and a close group of advisors “Eagle Wings Motorcycle Association”. A new logo was designed and put on the new Facebook page. But little else has been shared officially. It would not do the new organization any justice to dabble in rumor and speculation, which is about all the Facebook page has been over the first few weeks. It is time to take a deep breath and wait for more concrete news or opportunities for discussion.

So what do we do now? Simply stated, we don't do anything different. Texas chapters should continue to socialize. We should take every opportunity to ride, as weather permits. Until we get a concrete decision on what to do with a chapter funds (this is the property of the chapter and most importantly the chapter members), we should do nothing extravagant. I will continue to share information as it is known, so that we can Individually, and collectively decide what affiliation if any we will choose about the new EWMA. no matter what we choose, if we stay together, and continue to ride together, nothing has to change.

# Rider Education Corner

Last Monday many District Educators from across the US met with the Director of Rider Education, Susan Huttman for updates about the future of The Rider Education Program in the midst of the unsettled disposition of what we once knew as GWRRA. Despite what (if any) new structure evolves, despite whether you as a rider or co-rider choose to ride with a group, with a couple of friends or by yourself, safety should always be the forefront of any vehicle operator's mind. All the District Educators we've talked to agree that the training we have had through GWRRA programs; University courses, The Levels Program, as well as practice and experience should not be pushed under the rug and forgotten about. Although National Headquarters in Phoenix, AZ will shut their doors on July 31, 2022, as of now the Rider Education Program will continue to do business with a few changes:

\* Rider Education and University courses can still be presented until the end of the year by instructors whose credentials are current.

\* Insurance for Rider Courses will continue until December 31, 2022.

\* Class lists of participants should continue to be sent to the District Educator, however processing may take longer to show up in an individual's record now since the Rider Education database has been switched to "read only" and information can no longer be entered at District level.

- District Educators will forward the information to the person assigned to oversee that particular section (i.e. Rider courses -ARC & TRC, Co-Rider seminars, CPR/MFA courses, University courses, etc.)

\* Individuals will still have access to view their own information/records on line.

\* Levels applications will still be accepted and processed-

N.7 Level I-III

N.9 Level IV, Mater Tour Rider/Co-Rider, Senior Master, Grand Master and Life Grand Master

N.10 Levels data update

N.33A Level I, II,III and Master Retirements Request NO FEES WILL BE COLLECTED for any of the above EXCEPT FOR POSTAGE to send patches or pins if an individual desires them. Again, processing may take longer than before due to the District Educators not being able to update the database on the District/state level.

All of us are hoping that the Rider Education program or something very similar will continue as a new structure develops. We are grateful for all instructors past and present who have worked hard to help fellow riders, co-riders and evens folks outside the organization be more aware of the importance and practice of safety. We are grateful for all riders, co-riders, their friends and family who take the knowledge and skills attained through programs like this seriously. I think all would agree that knowledge and practice of safety skills can make a more enjoyable and fun ride.
