Praline Crunch

This crispy, crunchy, caramel Crispix snack mix is absolutely delicious and highly addictive!

Ingredients

- 1 c butter
- 2 1/4 c brown sugar
- 1/2 c corn syrup
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 18 oz box Crispix cereal
- 1/2 lb pecan halves (about 2 cups)

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 200°F.
- 2. In a large mixing bowl, add the cereal and pecans. Set aside.
- 3. In a medium-sized saucepan, combine the butter, brown sugar and corn syrup. Cook on medium-high heat until it comes to a boil.
- 4. Let the mixture boil for 5 minutes and remove from the heat.
- 5. Stir in the vanilla and salt.
- 6. Pour the mixture over the cereal and pecans and stir until the pieces are evenly coated, being careful not to crush the cereal.
- 7. Divide the mixture between two sheet pans and spread out evenly.
- 8. Bake for 1 hour, stirring each pan of praline crunch every 15 minutes.
- 9. Let cool and store in an airtight container.

I made this for a family gathering and everyone loved it.

The grocery store I where I shop only had 12 ounce boxes of Crispix I adjusted the recipe and used 2-12 ounce boxes. These are the adjusted ingredients:

1 1/3 cups butter

3 cups brown sugar

½ cup plus 2 2/3 tablespoons corn syrup

1 1/3 teaspoon vanilla

Crock-Pot Praline Pecans

Ingredients

- 4 cups pecans
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1 cup dark brown sugar
- · Four tablespoons unsalted butter
- Two tablespoon light corn syrup
- One egg white
- · Two teaspoons vanilla

Instructions

- 1. In a large bowl, beat the egg white until frothy.
- 2. Mix the pecans in the frothy egg white.
- 3. Stir in the sugar and the brown sugar.
- 4. Add in the melted butter, corn syrup, and vanilla.
- 5. Spray the crock-pot with a cooking spray.
- 6. Add the pecan mixture.
- 7. Cook for 3 -1/2 hours on low.
- 8. Stir the pecans every 20 to 30 minutes.
- 9. Remove the pecans from the crock-pot and let dry on parchment paper.
- 10. Separate the pecans as they dry.

Whiskey (Bourbon) Praline Pecans

1 lb. pecan halves

¹/₄ cup sugar +1 tablespoon for later

1/4 cup brown sugar

1 tablespoon cinnamon

1/8 teaspoon cayenne pepper

1 teaspoon salt

1 large egg white

2 tablespoons whiskey or bourbon

1 tablespoon honey

1 tablespoon vanilla

Preheat oven to 250 degrees. Line baking sheet with parchment paper. In large bowl combine ¼ cup sugar, brown sugar, cinnamon, nutmeg, cayenne, and salt. Set aside.

In a 2nd bowl, combine egg white, whiskey or bourbon, honey, and vanilla. Whisk together until frothy. Add pecans and stir to coat. Remove pecans with a slotted spoon and add to sugar mixture, leaving extra liquid behind. Stir until all pecans are well-coated. Sprinkle extra tablespoon of sugar over pecans and give a quick stir. Pour pecans onto parchment lined baking sheet and bake for 80 minutes, stirring every 20 minutes. Remove from oven. Pecans will be sticky until they cool.

Could substitute almonds for pecans.


