Since it's getting warmer in Texas, here are some tips for riding a motorcycle in hot weather:

Dress appropriately: Wear lightcolored clothing in a breathable fabric to reflect the sun's rays and allow air to circulate your body. You can also wear a cooling vest or bandana to keep you cooler.

Stay hydrated: Drink plenty of water before, during, and after your ride.

Plan your route: Avoid riding during the hottest part of the day. Ride early in the day or take a long siesta during the hottest part of the day.

Take care of your bike: Check your bike's coolant levels and tire pressure before you ride.

Open helmet vents: Open the vents on your motorcycle helmet to increase air flow.

Watch for signs of heat-related illnesses: If you're riding on a hot day, watch for signs of heat-related illnesses such as heat exhaustion or heat stroke.



There were so many rides on such beautifully forested tree lined roads, that I totally regret not being able to ride the bike up there this time. But I'm working on it! That is all everybody talked about, and with the only rain coming on Friday was not even all day. There was plenty of opportunities to hit the road. As if that wasn't enough, there were games to play, prizes to win, vendors to see, and a surprising number of great restaurants in the Harrison Arkansas area. Friday night they had a 70s dance with karaoke and a good DJ. There were training classes for those that wanted them. All in all, a good time was had by all. The only downer this whole weekend was the call from my daughter informing me that a hailstorm had just passed through our neighborhood in Plano TX. Quite a bit of damage considering the hail did not quite get to the size of golf balls. Now to see how much the insurance will cover.

This Arkansas trip helps put the spring 2023 rally season behind in Region B. I believe there are several rallies still yet to occur in the north, and in the east. South Carolina for one, where one of our good friends is involved in the district team. We certainly do wish we could go. As for Texas, two ride-ins have been scheduled already for late summer early fall. Chapter O, now known as The Capital Wings, is planning a ride-in at Lufkin, Texas in October, and the District will be putting on a ride-in in Glen Rose, Texas in late September. In total we had over 92 participants, not counting those who showed up on Saturday that we did not charge. Nate from Chapter R, a friend of ours, arrived just in time to help us dismantle the signs and prepare for closing ceremonies. Friday night we were entertained by an Elvis enthusiast who sang quite well and kept us entertained for a couple hours. After that,

karaoke had so many participants, one after the other. Who knew motorcyclists could sing so well! In either case Mike Panetta personally took care of Elvis and the DJ. Many thanks Sir; he made a lot of people happy. During the whole weekend we had but 30 minutes of thunderstorms and small hail there in Kerrville. When everything was said and done, the district came away with close to \$1,400 in profit, which will ensure that we can pay the chapter charter fees for all chapters that wish to continue with EWMA. We likely have enough to also help in continuing Rider education by sponsoring both equipment and trainers. I would say 2023 looks quite good.


