I got to Kerrville about four-thirty, checked in, and had dinner at Cracker Barrel. Then I took the trike to a car wash and washed it.

On Thursday, I rode the Three Sisters ride. I did my usual route: Take Hwy 16 to Medina, then RR337 west to Camp Wood, Hwy 55 to Barksdale, RR335 north to Hwy 41, 41 east to RR336. RR336 to Leakey (stop at the Hog Pen for some barbecue), then Hwy 83 north to Hwy 39. Take 39 east to Ingram (visit the Stonehenge replica), then follow 27 back to Kerrville. It was a fun ride.

Friday and Saturday, I stayed at the rally all day. I did the vendor walk, played Bingo, and watched the first part of the Elvis show.

I returned home on Sunday. Bobby Williams was not quite ready to go when I wanted to leave, so I started on. Bobby caught up with me on the road. I was going 60, and he wanted to go faster, so he went on ahead. I stayed at 60 almost all the way home. I found that the trike gets much better fuel mileage at 60 than at 70, and I get to my destination just about as fast. I passed by Bobby refueling at Hamilton, so I kept going. I used my extra tank so I did not have to stop. I made the entire trip home in 5½ hours.

There were 94 attendees at the rally. Everyone had a good time. Dan and Donna did a great job putting the rally on, and we hope that more folks will come and join us at the next one.



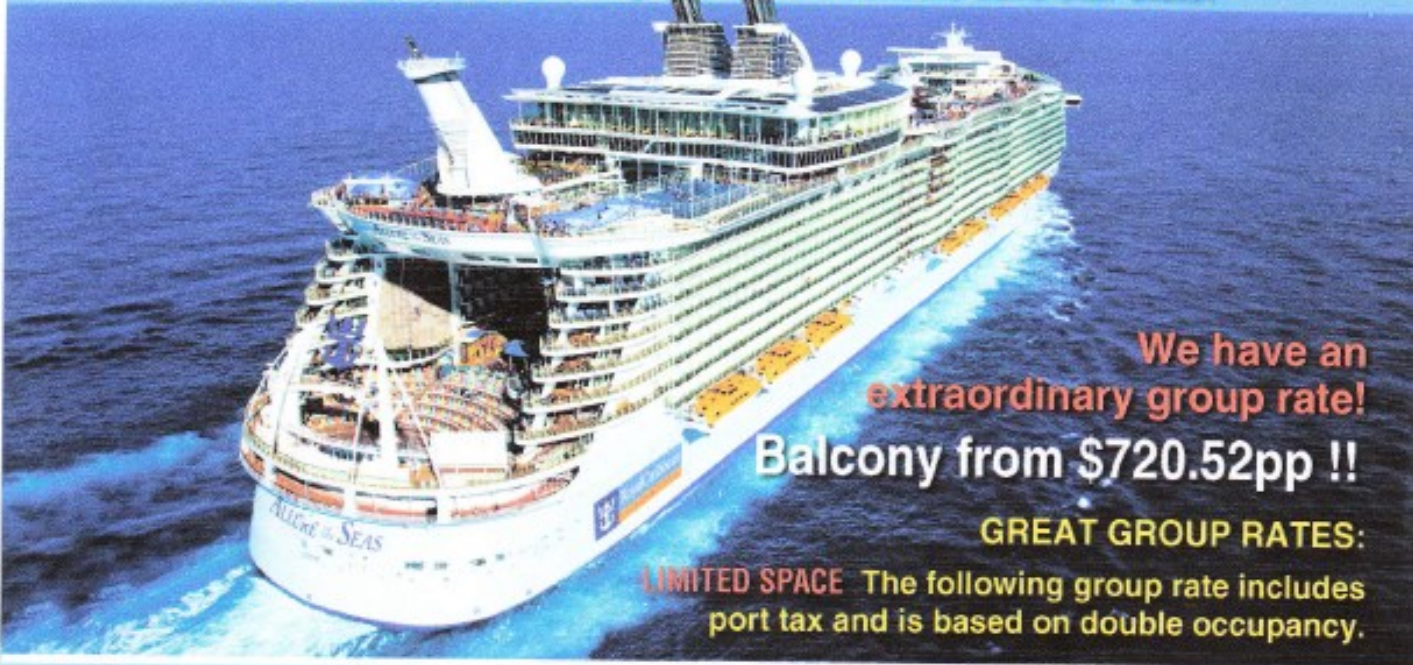
