This month's recipes were submitted by Barbara Wiggins. Thank you Barb.

SOPAPILLA CHEESECAKE

- 2 Cans crescent roll dough
- 2 (8 oz.) pkgs. Cream cheese (softened)
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 stick margarine
- 1 tbs. Vanilla

Spray 9 ½" x 11" cake pan with oil. Roll 1 can of dough in pan.

Mix cream cheese, sugar, egg & vanilla with mixer.

Pour on dough.

Put 2nd can of dough on top of cream cheese mixture.

Melt margarine and pour evenly over top.

Mix ¼ cup sugar & 1 tsp. Cinnamon and sprinkle over butter.

Bake @ 375 degrees until golden brown. (about 20 min.)

Halloween Harvest Hash Chex

Mix

Ingredients

For the Sauce:

- 3/4 cup Butter, melted
- ³/₄ cup Brown Sugar, packed
- 2 Tablespoons Vanilla Extract For the Mix:
- 1 box Rice Chex [365g (12 oz)]
- 1 bag Bugles [213g (7 oz) bag]
- 4 cups Pretzels
- 1 heaping cup Candy Corn
- 1 heaping cup Candy Corn Pumpkins
- 1 bag Reese's Pieces [230g (8oz)]

Instructions

- Preheat the oven to 275°F.
- Melt the butter in the microwave in medium bowl or measuring cup.
- Add the brown sugar and vanilla extract and whisk well until combined and dissolved.
- In a VERY large bowl, add the Chex cereal, pretzels and Bugles.
- Pour the sauce over the cereal mixture and toss gently until evenly coated.
- Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper.
- Divide mixture on the two baking sheets and spread in even layers.
- Bake for 45 minutes, stirring every 15 minutes.
- Remove from the oven and allow it to cool. Then add it to a large bowl, along with the candy corn, pumpkins and Reese's Pieces. Toss to combine.
- 10. Store in airtight container.

Notes

This recipe makes enough for approximately 30 portions that are 1 cup each.


